

BERKELEY, CALIFORNIA

LOCATION: East of San Francisco across the Bay Bridge, you will find the compact hamlet of Berkeley. Sheltered by rolling hills and bordered by San Francisco Bay, it is centrally located to Bay Area attractions and just a short BART ride to San Francisco.

POPULATION: 104,000

DESCRIPTION: Berkeley is a small town (18 square miles) with big city character, featuring a world-renowned university, diverse cultural arts, history, quaint shopping districts, gardens and more.

TRANSPORTATION: The Oakland International Airport, less than 15 miles away, is served by Alaska, Aloha, American, ATA, Continental, Delta, JetBlue, Mexicana, Skybus, Southwest, TACA, United and US Airways. San Francisco Airport is 25 miles and San Jose Int'l is 45 miles.

Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) trains serve three stations within Berkeley. Scheduled train and bus services also are available for travel to, from and within Berkeley, the greater San Francisco Bay Area and points beyond. BART is also available to the Oakland and

San Francisco Airports.

WEATHER: The San Francisco East Bay is often referred to the "Sunny Side of the Bay". Berkeley, like San Francisco, sits on the water and experiences a mild climate year round.
